

How to Donate to the American Haiku Archives

Step 1: Search the California State Library online catalog.

Because the American Haiku Archives may already have specific books that you are interested in donating, please search the online catalog to see if the collection already includes them. If in doubt, please send the material anyway, or consult with an advisory board member or the California State Library staff. To search the online catalog, go to the California State Library web site located at: <http://www.library.ca.gov/> and go to the "search for books" link or go directly to the online catalog at: http://www.lib.state.ca.us/web2/tramp2.exe/log_in?guest&SETTING_KEY=English&screen=home.html
